Bring an item for tacos: couple of tomatoes, onions, sauce, cheese, lettuce, or shells (soft or hard)

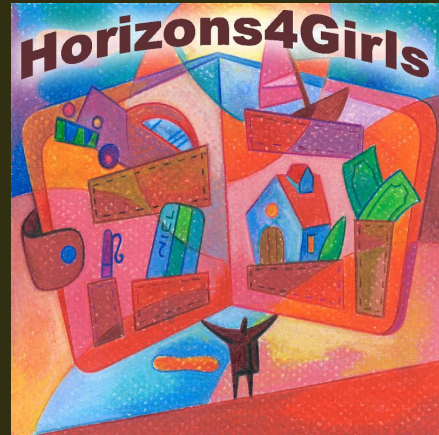


Just a fun, social gathering! You can meet students, teachers, volunteers, donors and enjoy a good time.
