

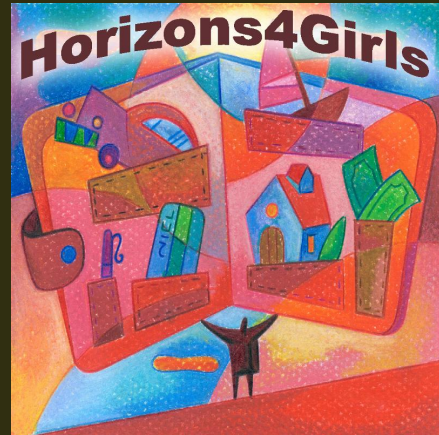

### HARVEST FEST HALF MARATHON & 10K PROCEEDS TO BENEFIT HORIZONS4GIRLS

SHEBOYGAN, Wis. (August 12, 2014) - Organizers of the second annual Harvest Fest Half Marathon & 10k run in Sheboygan, WI, announced their new relationship with Horizons4Girls ([www.horizons4girls.com](http://www.horizons4girls.com)) as the event's designated charity. Proceeds from the race will benefit Horizons4Girls' programs assisting young women when they

need it most. "We look forward to helping Horizons4Girls development mentoring opportunities for the young women they serve through this event," said Jeff Grady, organizer of the Harvest Fest Half Marathon & 10k (HFH). Grady adds, "Our goal to help them make a significant impact on these girls' lives and to be a significant fundraiser for them now and in the future."

Set for September 27th, 2014, The Harvest Fest Half Marathon compliments Sheboygan's annual Harvest Fest, bringing morning festivities East of the Sheboygan River.

The Harvest Fest runs start and finish at the Harbor Center district on Sheboygan's lakefront. Half marathon runners proceed along the flat and fast course toward Kohler-Andrae State Park for the turnaround. The event also features a shorter 10K (6.2 mile) race for those not ready for the longer distance event. Festivities begin Friday 9/27/2013 with packet pickup and Expo at Blue Harbor Resort, include the race on Saturday (8am start), and a post race party until 1:30pm featuring music, games, and food. Participants and their families can use the Harbor Center shuttle service to make the easy trip to the districts' annual Harvest Fest activities across the river.

Additional sponsors include the host hotel, Blue Harbor Resort and the Sheboygan Harbor Centre Business Improvement District. "We look forward to working with Horizons4Girls, the Resort and the Improvement District to bring a new exciting event to Sheboygan," said Grady.
