Everything that they do is done by volunteers! Of course those volunteers are interviewed, screened, references checked. Then they are trained. They mentor in a group setting, go through additional training and after 20 hours of field work can become certified -- giving them the option of working one on one with a student. All of this is done on a very flexible schedule, even allowing mentors to work full time, part time, run their own business, continue their education and even travel and enjoy retirement.
